- 4. Staff recommendation to modify REG117.4, REG120.1 and REG120.5.2 by deleting requirement that AQHA duplicate and correction forms be "duly notarized".

The modified rules to read as follows:

"REG117.4 Correction of an original registration certificate may be obtained by the current record owner or owner's authorized agent by filing the proper AQHA form completed in all respects, along with four full-view photographs of the horse showing both sides, front and rear views."

"REG120.1 AQHA may issue a duplicate registration certificate after the current record owner or authorized agent files the proper AQHA from, completed in all respects and stating the circumstances under which the original registration certificate was lost or destroyed, and pays the required fee. Such request is to be accompanied by four full-view photographs of the horse, showing both sides, front and rear views."

"REG120.5.2 AQHA form signed by each party who had the original certificate in his or her possession after the record owner."

- 5. Amend REG104 so as to allow for the advancement of a horse from the appendix registry to the numbered registry once the evidence of any thoroughbred horses has been removed from the horse's pedigree as listed on its registration certificate (current registration certificate lists 3 generations, i.e., parents, grandparents and great-grandparents are listed on a registration certificate, but not great-great grandparents).
- 6. Add a subsection to REG104.2 to allow horses to advance from the appendix registry to the numbered registry based upon their awards, achievements, money earned and/or points from AQHA alliance partners.
- 7. Add a subsection to REG104 to provide as follows:

A horse is eligible to receive an appendix certificate if all of the following apply:

 horse was foaled in an international country with a stud book dedicated to the sole purpose of sprint racing which is recognized by the AQHA;

- 2. horse was identified by the standards set out and required by the Jockey Club of North America or any Thoroughbred registry recognized by the Jockey Club of North America;
- 3. horse was issued a registration certificate by such stud book; and
- 4. horse traces to a minimum of 93.75 (15/16) lineage to horses registered with the AQHA and the Jockey Club of North America or any Thoroughbred registry recognized by the Jockey Club of North America.
- 8. Add a subsection to REG108 to read as follows:

"When the sire and dam of a foal have tested negative for the 5 panel genetic test with an appropriate designation appearing on their registration certificates, the designation "N/N" will be assigned to the foal upon registration as well."

- 9. Request that, in addition to accepting test results from UC Davis, AQHA accept previous and future genetic testing results from other accredited labs.
- 10. Add REG118.6 to provide that a foal's original name may not be subsequently changed if the original registration applicant requests such restriction on the registration application.

- 12. Adjournment
