## AQHA Ranch Riding - Pattern 1


I. Walk
2. Trot
3. Extend the trot, at the top of the arena, stop
4. 360 degree turn to the left
5. Left lead I/2 circle, lope to the center
6. Change leads (simple or flying)
7. Right lead I/2 circle
8. Extended lope up the long side of the arena (right lead)
9. Collect back to a lope around the top of the arena and back to center
10. Break down to an extended trot
II. Walk over poles
12. Stop and back

## AQHA Ranch Riding - Pattern 2


I. Walk
2. Trot
3. Extended trot
4. Left lead lope
5. Stop, I I/2 turn right
6. Extended lope
7. Collect to working lope-right lead
8. Change leads (simple or flying)
9. Walk
10. Walk over logs
II. Trot
12. Extended trot
13. Stop and back

## AQHA Ranch Riding - Pattern 3


I. Walk to the left around corner of the arena
2. Trot
3. Extend alongside of the arena and around the corner to center
4. Stop, side pass right
5. 360 degree turn each direction (either way Ist)
6. Walk
7. Trot
8. Lope left lead
9. Extend the lope
10. Change leads (simple or flying)
II. Collect to the lope
12. Extend Trot
13. Stop and back

## AQHA Ranch Riding - Pattern 4


I. Walk
2. Trot serpentine
3. Lope left lead around the end of the arena and then diagonally across the arena
4. Change leads (simple or flying) and
5. Lope on the right lead around end of the arena
6. Extend lope on the straight away and around corner to the center of the arena
7. Extend trot around corner of the arena
8. Collect to a trot
9. Trot over logs
10. Stop, do 360 degree turn each direction (either direction Ist) (L-R or R-L)
II. Walk, stop and back

I. Walk
2. Trot
3. Extended lope-right lead
4. Lope-right lead
5. Change leads(simple or flying)
6. Lope left lead
7. Extended trot
8. Stop, side pass left, side pass right, I/2 way
9. Walk over logs

12. Stop, $360^{\circ}$ turn left, back

3. Extend the trot, at the top of the arena ,stop
4. 360 degree turn to the left
5. Left lead I/2 circle, lope to the center
6. Change leads (simple or flying)
7. Right lead $\mathrm{I} / 2$ circle
8. Extended lope up the long side of the arena (right lead)
9. Collect back to a lope around the top of the arena and back to center
10. Break down to an extended trot
II. Walk over poles
12. Stop and back

6. working lope.
7. Change leads.

9. Stop. $360^{\circ}$ turn either direction.

IO. Jog around corner and I/2 way down long side.
II. Walk, walk over logs and walk to end.
12. Stop and back 15 feet.

2. Side pass left across first log. Side pass $\mathrm{I} / 2$ way to the right.

4. Extended jog around corner and $\mathrm{I} / 2$ way across end.
5. Jog around corner.
6. $360^{\circ}$ turn either direction. $360^{\circ}$ turn the opposite direction.
7. Lope on right lead down the long side.
8. 8. Extended lope around the end and across the arena.
9. Change leads, continuing to extend the lope.
10. Stop. Hesitate walk I/2 way across end.
II. Lope on the left lead, crossing the arena.
12. Extend the trot to the end.
13. Jog across end.
14. Stop and back.
